

What you need to know...

Supplies: Everyone is required to bring the following:

- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package glue sticks
- box of tissues
- Clean change of clothes to keep at school-just in case. (Please put them in a zip lock bag labeled with your child's name)!

- Pre-K children bring a package of Crayola thin markers.
- Children in 3-4 year old classes bring a package of Crayola regular markers.

- Tues/Thurs students bring a package of sandwich sized zip lock bags.
- 4 day afternoon students bring a package of colored pencils.
- Monday/Wed/Friday students bring a package of napkins.

- Label everything your child brings to school-especially their backpack, and outdoor clothing (hats, mittens, jackets, and boots).

Preschool/Parent Communication: You will receive weekly email announcements. We have found this to be a more efficient way to communicate with the parents than through papers that can get lost in backpacks. Please read them carefully because we may request some information from you or require you to participate in an activity at home with your child!

Snack: Each child will have a turn to share a snack and beverage with their class. If a child has a food allergy, the allergic food will be posted on the parent board outside the classroom, and listed on the snack calendar each month. Snack should be healthy and low in sugar. Fruit juices must be 100% fruit juice. **All snacks and beverages must be purchased at the store.** Suggestions: popcorn, snack bars, pretzels, cheese, snack crackers, yogurt, fresh fruit, fresh vegetables, etc... (We do have several children who have severe allergies to peanuts, so we are asking that snacks do not include peanuts or peanut butter.)

Class Calendar/Snack Calendar: The class calendar will list, by day, the events and themes for each week. Special events will be listed on the calendar as well. The calendar will also list the name of the child who is responsible for snack that day.

Birthday Treats & Books: The snack will be coordinated with a day closest to your child's birthday. If your child has a summer birthday, we will celebrate half-birthdays. Please try to purchase mini cupcakes, cookies, or ice cream treats. These seem to work best for cleaning up! You can donate a new book in your child's name in

honor of their birthday! Simply purchase a book and give it to their teacher. They will label the book with your child's name and birthday and read it on their birthday celebration as well!

Scholastic Book Club: Scholastic Book Club allows you to order and pick up award winning books through school. This is a great way to expand your home library! Monthly you will receive a handout listing all the monthly choices. When you choose to participate in the Book Club, Christ Victorious Preschool benefits as well by receiving free books based on the number of book orders from you.

Chapel: Please consider joining your child during our chapel time. We worship in the sanctuary once a week with the children. The time commitment is only ten minutes and you are welcome to bring siblings.
